Jeff Hickman was appointed to the State Regents in 2017 and serves as chairman, Hickman is president and CEO of the Oklahoma Grain and Feed Association. Dr. Janet Cunningham serves as the 19th president of Northwestern Oklahoma State University. She was named the school's chief executive officer on July 1, 2006, following her appointment by the Board of Regents of the Regional University System of Oklahoma.


